Our new "Wibit" five station (for now) inflatable obstacle course will be a highlight at the waterfront this summer!

We have remodeled all the Sub Senior boys' bunks with pine paneling and showers. The buildings look absolutely beautiful. In girls camp the Lower Seniors' Hexagon bunk has also been remodeled with new bathrooms and showers, and a pine paneled interior. The hot water source for all new showers will be energy saving and efficient tankless hot water heaters.

We have built a new boy's shower house for this summer; complimenting the showers that are already in the bunks...I can hear the boys cheering right now! It will be located right off of Court Sava in lower camp and be very accessible to all campers.

There will be new bleachers for seating on Moss Park this summer to enhance the spectator experience for all our soccer tournaments.

In addition to all this, we are happy to share with everyone that plans are now underway for two new capital improvements that will be completed by the 2012 season. We are now designing a new administrative office building that will take the place of our old office and director's cabin. In its place will be a fantastic new building that will not only be an office but a 2nd story directors home on top. Joe Eisner, one of our camp parents, and an award-winning architect in NYC, is designing a building that will set a new standard in Camp architectural design both for its innovation and sustainable green philosophy. We will be keeping you abreast of all the developments as they unfold shortly after camp finishes this summer.

We are also planning a new gymnastics facility for 2012 as well. As this sport has become more and more popular at Lenox we know the need for a dedicated building has become essential. This building will be solely designated for gymnastics and cheerleading, but large enough for a lot of fun recreational activities throughout the summer.
