Dear Friends,

With camp 7 weeks away, we are making final preparations and kicking into high gear for the 2007 season. We have made several improvements this year to Camp Lenox, including our stunning, new website. As many of you have said, "It is absolutely beautiful, well organized, and extremely informative". Other improvements include:

A new climbing wall and ropes course will be built behind Alumni Hall. The climbing wall will be 45' high and will have 3 new elements attached to it, including an incredible vertical play pen. We think its going to be superb!

A new bathroom facility will be built near Alumni hall. All the campers and staff going to Moss Park, the tennis courts and Alumni hall for activities will have a facility to use.

We have completely renovated with tongue and groove pine paneling the following bunks: Bunk 22 - Scout boys, bunk 17- Junior boys, Bunk 18 - Junior boys, and the Hilton - Explorer girls. Showers have been put in all the Junior boys bunks this winter as well.

Alumni Hall has also been improved. One entire side of the building interior has been pine paneled and it looks spectacular. We have also improved the upstairs conditioning room and converted it into our new gymnastics center. With air conditioning and plenty of space, you gymnasts are going to love this facility! The weight training room has also been paneled and looks awesome!

On the programming side, we are looking to enter representative teams in grades 6 - 10 in a big AAU sanctioned basketball tournament on July 11th and 12th this summer at the University of Massachusetts. This will be an opportunity for boys who play Travel and AAU to continue during the summer while representing Camp Lenox.

We have heard the lice situation in the New York area schools has been bad this past year. As a preventative measure, we have hired "Licenders" to come to camp June 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> to examine each and every camper as they enter camp. This team of professionals will come with the necessary equipment to treat any camper or staff member with lice and ensure we have a lice free environment. Please let your child know that the inspection will occur as they arrive at camp.
